

BRIEF REPORT ON FLOOD RELIEF ACTIVITY AT MANJAGUNI

We visited Manjaguni village and surrounding areas near the Gangavali river, which were completely flooded by the incessant rains during the last couple of days.

Almost all the households/ petty shops on the banks of the river were inundated with water and mud. People had to evacuate their homes immediately carrying nothing except the clothes which they were wearing. They were shifted to the care centres created at schools situated on higher ground.

As per the instructions of Chairman, KWT, we immediately took stock of the situation. The district administration has provided only accommodation and food. One health officer with the assistance of an Asha worker is entrusted with the task of providing medical attention to the affected people in the entire Manjaguni area.

After conducting due enquiries and talking with the people, we found that they primarily needed bedsheets, bed-mats, pure drinking water, medicines, sanitary pads, etc.

Within two hours, we could mobilize all the required items and once again we visited the care center with the materials. The same was distributed among the affected people. The medicine stock was handed over to the Doctor in charge of the area.

During the distribution process, District In-charge Minister, Shri Shivaram Hebbar along with DC Mr. Muhilan, ZP CEO Ms. Priyanga and other officials visited the centre. He was very appreciative about the efforts made by the Trust in mitigating the sufferings of the flood affected people. The beneficiaries also communicated their gratitude to the Trust.
