MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

ON COOPERATION IN PROMOTION OF HEALTH/ HEALTH SCHEMES &
ORGANIZING WORKSHOPS, CAMPS and TALKS

BETWEEN

KWT'S GOKHALE CENTENARY COLLEGE, ANKOLA

&

PRIMARY HEALTH CENTER BELSE. ANKOLA.

Recognizing the Importance of health and the way to promote health KWT'S GOKHALE CENTENARY COLLEGE, and PRIMARY HEALTH CENTRE, BELSE inspired by the desire to promote Health among our students, staff and society, have now reached the following understanding:

KWT'S GOKHALE CENTENARY COLLEGE, ANKOLA AND TALUKA HEALTH OFFICE / PRIMARY HEALTH CENTER BELSE. ANKOLA, both jointly shall be referred to as the "Parties" in this contract.

Dr. B.V.Shettigar (Principal, Gokhale Centenary college, Ankola) signed this document on be-half of Gokhale Centenary College as first party and Dr. Nitin Hosmelkar & Dr. Archana Naik (TALUKA HEALTH OFFICER / OFFICER PRIMARY HEALTH CENTER BELSE. ANKOLA.) signed on behalf of second party.

TERM: The parties agree that this contract shall be valid for a of three years effective from the date of execution .

DURATION:This MOU is at-will and may be modified by mutual consent of authorized officials from GOKHALE CENTENARY COLLEGE, ANKOLA AND TALUKA HEALTH OFFICE / PRIMARY HEALTH CENTER BELSE. ANKOLA.. This MOU shall become effective upon signature by authorized representatives from Gokhale Centenary college, Ankola and Primary Health Center Belse, ANKOLA, and will remain in effect until modified or terminated by any one of the partners by mutual consent. In the absence of mutual agreement by the authorized officials, this MOU shall be renewed annually by signature of both parties. This MOU is not a commitment of funds. Each party shall maintain the ownness of any expenses incurred resulting from the pursuit of common goals unless separately agreed upon.

PURPOSE: This MOU will allow and encourage the development of mutual Community Health Improvement Planning and strategy which results from the Community Health Needs Assessment.

This agreement is made on 24/12/2021 and is intended to outline and formalize the partnership and agreements between KWT'S Gokhale Centenary College, Ankola's Youth Red Cross Unit and Primary Health Center, Belse Ankola. This agreement is supplemental to the Master Agreement between KWT'S Gokhale Centenary College, Ankola and Taluka Health Office / Primary Health Center, Ankola. This agreement is designed to

- a) articulate the vision, mutual goals and expectations of the partnership,
- b) outline current services,
- c) clarify roles, responsibilities and communication mechanisms at the college site.

VISION: The vision of this College – Health care center partnership is: to promote and foster health primarily among students and also among the staff and public at large.

Description of activities to be done under the MOU: Case management and health counseling • Physical exams • Health education related to nutrition/physical fitness, sexual health, etc. • Youth development programs,

including peer health education, • Outreach to youth and their families • Community-wide health promotion events and activities • Referrals to health and social service providers on and off site.

Eligibility and Cost • The activities and events are open to all students. Students' health needs will be assessed and students may be referred to their primary care provider for continuity of care. • All services will be provided to students, staff and general population at no out of pocket cost. •

Shared Goals and Objectives :The shared goals and objectives (e.g. outcomes, strategies, utilization, focus populations, etc.) for this partnership are:

- 1) Increase utilization of health services by students on campus
- 2) Increase utilization of health services by staff to a) improve staff wellness and, b) increase staff knowledge of how to identify health needs of students and when/where to refer students for services
- 3) Conduct or arrange health education workshops for students, staff, general public in order to increase family engagement around health issues

4) Expand services to students at feeder schools and/or broader adolescent community to increase access to health services for these populations

Expectations of Both Parties:

The College and the Youth Red Cross Unit in particular will provide:

- health center with space for provision of agreed upon services and activities.
- Provide school-based health center coordinator and staff required to access the school-based health center space,
- Provide the school-based health center with access to the venue, computers.

.Provide space in Hallways and notice boards for Announcements & Health Education Information

The Primary Health Center will:

- Arrange for workshops, promotions and displays of health related schemes.
- . Arrange for resource persons and technical staff during health screening and other workshops.

Both parties of the Memorandum of Understanding shall work towards promoting and improving the health of the students/ staff / public and at the same time work towards educating them on various schemes related to health services provided by the Government.

The person who will be incharge and act as coordinator of the activities under this MOUS shall be
