

# CODE OF CONDUCT – 2018-2019

## GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS / PARENTS

### INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED METICULOUSLY

**Respect for the rules will ensure that all students will benefit from the learning opportunities the College provides. Students are expected to follow the instructions at all times and maintain discipline of the College.**

1. The students should attend the College regularly and maintain the requisite attendance according to the Karnatak University rules.
2. The students should be punctual to the College and should be present in the classrooms before the morning prayers.
3. The students should compulsorily attend all National Festivals that the College celebrates.
4. The students are not allowed to go out of the College campus during College hours without seeking prior permission.
5. No student should be found unnecessarily waiting outside the College campus in the morning, afternoon or evening hours.
6. The students permitted to come to College by bicycles should keep them in good working condition and park them systematically in the parking area allotted to them.
7. The students will not use any form of verbal abuses or misbehave in the College premises. Any means of bullying / ragging is strictly forbidden. Strict action will be taken against such student, which may even amount to striking off the name from the College Roll.
8. The students are expected to wear the **College uniform everyday** as specified by the College in a clean, tidy condition and with pride in their appearance. ID cards compulsory for all.
9. No jewellery is permitted. Children are not allowed to bring costly articles, money, mobiles, etc. to College. For any loss of such articles, the College will not be held responsible.
10. The students should respect the College property and all equipments of the College. The College will levy fines on any damages caused.
11. The students should respect their peers and teachers.
12. The students are expected to complete all their projects, notes and assignments in time.
13. Every student should maintain the academic standard of the College. Parents will be called immediately if their ward's performance is going low day by day & appropriate action in this regard will be taken by the College Authorities.
14. The students should keep the classrooms and College premises clean and tidy at all times. Eating chocolates, etc. and disposing the wrappers on the corridors, playground or toilets should be strictly avoided.
15. Unnecessary movements in the corridors during the class hours should be avoided.
16. Students must walk quietly & orderly in the corridors during recess break, lunch break, practical periods, etc.
17. There will be regular sports practice for the students on the College ground. Practice timings are as follows:  
*Morning Session - 8.00 a.m. to 9.00 a.m.*  
*Evening Session - 4.00 p.m. to 5.30 p.m.*
18. Use of Mobile phones is strictly prohibited and students are under surveillance of CCTV Cameras in class rooms and Campus.
19. Every student should endeavor to make the College proud by excelling in studies and good manners.
