A BRIEF REPORT

The college Youth Red Cross Unit lend its helping hand to Krugers Foundation for the relief work in connection with reaching out to the people who were displaced due to floods by the incessant rains near Manjagunivillage and surrounding areas.

Almost all the households/ petty shops on the banks of the river were inundated with water and mud. People had to evacuate their homes immediately carrying nothing except the clothes which they were wearing. They were shifted to the care centre created at schools situated on higher ground.

Our college team consisting of 15 students and 3 staff members were part of the visiting team to the relief work undertaken. After conducting due enquiries and talking with the people, we found that they primarily needed bedsheets, bed-mats, pure drinking water, medicines, sanitary pads, etc.

During the distribution process, District In-charge Minister, Shri Shivaram Hebbar along with DC Mr. Muhilan, ZP CEO Ms. Priyanga and other officials visited the centre. He was very appreciative about the efforts made by the Trust in mitigating the sufferings of the flood affected people. The beneficiaries also communicated their gratitude to the Trust.





Shri Prakash Kunji and Shri Ganapati Tandel of P.M. High School, Dr. Praveen Naik of G.C.College and Mr. Anand Keni, Quality Graphics, Ankola, helped us to conduct the survey, procure & distribute the relief materials. Asha workers deputed through Primary health care centre. The cost of the relief materials are as under
